



Changing the face of Main Street, Cobleskill

The Cobleskill Partnership, Inc. – in cooperation with SUNY Cobleskill, the Village of Cobleskill, the citizens of Cobleskill and the Cobleskill Rotary Club – has redesigned the corner of Main and Division Streets into a Community Plaza with tables, benches and landscaping to help beautify the downtown area. Many of you will remember the corner of Main and Division Streets as the location where the Olsen’s Department Store stood until it burned in 1971.

SUNY Cobleskill and especially its students are an invaluable partner in this project, making available resources, in-kind donations and talents at all levels:

- The College’s Fall 2008 Construction and Design Class under the supervision of Instructor Steve Mullarkey coordinated a design competition resulting in the winning design for the Community Plaza being created by Dana Hamm of Middleburgh.
- The 2008-2009 Student Government Association in cooperation with the Council for Student Activities and Culinary Arts and Travel and Tourism students spearheaded the campus and community Rock n ‘Roll Tribute Show, a major fundraising effort.

- Summer 2009 student interns helped prep the site in cooperation with village leaders and community volunteers.
- The Spring 2010 Plant Sciences Department Landscape Construction students again under the instruction of Steve Mullarkey experienced “real life real learning” when they transformed Ms Hamm’s design into reality as they finalized the building of the Plaza project.

Of course, none of this would be possible without the land for the Plaza which has been generously donated by Dr. and Mrs. William Lancaster.

As the Plaza project nears completion, we know that many of you have a warm spot in your heart and fond memories of your days in Cobleskill.
